## **VISA INSTURCTION**

- 1. Consular hours 10.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. in all working days. Office closes Saturday, Sunday and announced official holiday. Minimum 24 hours required for processing of visa.
- 2. All visas are issued according to the stated PURPOSE OF VISIT which must be CLEARLY STATED by the applicant. Failure to do so shall inevitably incur delays.
- 3. Do check your passport whether it is valid for over 6 months from the date of visa.
- 4. The visas issued by the Embassy of Consulates only give right to ENTER THE GAMBIA.

#### 5. DOCUMENTS TO BE PRODUCED

- -Passport Valid for at least 6 Months & ( Photocopy of the Passport).
- -Visa Application Form Complete & Signed.
- -Two Recent Passport Size Photographs.
- -Certificate of Yellow Fever Vaccination & (Photocopy of Yellow Fever Certificate)
- -Sponsoring Letter from Indian Co./ Employer OR Invitation Letter From The Gambia OR US\$ Endorsement in the Passport OR Bank Statements.
- -Appropriate Fees (see 7)

#### 6. An Entry Visa is granted in the following categories:

- -TOURIST VISA granted to those who are bonafied tourist of good standing and conduct for a stay in THE GAMBIA upto 60 days.
- -A TRANSIT VISA for stay in THE GAMBIA for few days is granted a person of adequate means traveling in transit thorough the Republic to other Countries. A confirmed travel document (all tickets etc) showing THE GAMBIA as a point of TRANSIT.
- -BUSINESS VISA a letter from your employer and/or business counterpart in THE GAMBIA in case of work in THE GAMBIA, a letter of employment from your prospective employer.
- -FOR OTHER PURPOSES please submit EVIDENCE SUBSTANTIATING YOUR PURPOSE of STAY.

## 7. VISA FEES

6 Months	Double / Multiple	Rs. 2000/-
1 Yesar	Multiple Entry	Rs. 4000/-

All fees shall be paid by Bank Draft or Cash in favour of "CONSULATE OF THE GAMBIA" payable at New Delhi. Visa Fees shall be non refundable.

- 8. A person entering THE GAMBIA must have in his possession travellers cheques or in cash convertible money reasonable to the extent of stay or credit card.
- One who applies for a kind of visa should not accept to take benefit to other kind of visa upon arrival in THE GAMBIA.

## 10. HEALTH REQUIRMENTS (SUBJECTS TO CHANGES)

Persons holding passports of or having residence in countries in the Yellow Fever area must produce a valid international health certificate for Yellow Fever at point of entry into THE GAMBIA.
